### **Jay G. Forsythe, College of Charleston**

Jay G. Forsythe is an Assistant Professor of Chemistry and Biochemistry at College of Charleston, a public liberal arts university in Charleston, SC. Dr. Forsythe obtained his B.S. in Chemistry from Furman University in 2009 and his Ph.D. in Chemistry from Vanderbilt University in 2014 under Prof. John A. McLean. From 2014 to 2016, he was an NSF/NASA Center for Chemical Evolution postdoctoral fellow at Georgia Institute of Technology under Profs. Facundo M. Fernández and Nicholas V. Hud. Dr. Forsythe began his independent career at College of Charleston in 2016, where he teaches general and analytical chemistry courses and performs research with undergraduates on the chemical evolution of peptides in model primordial environments.
