



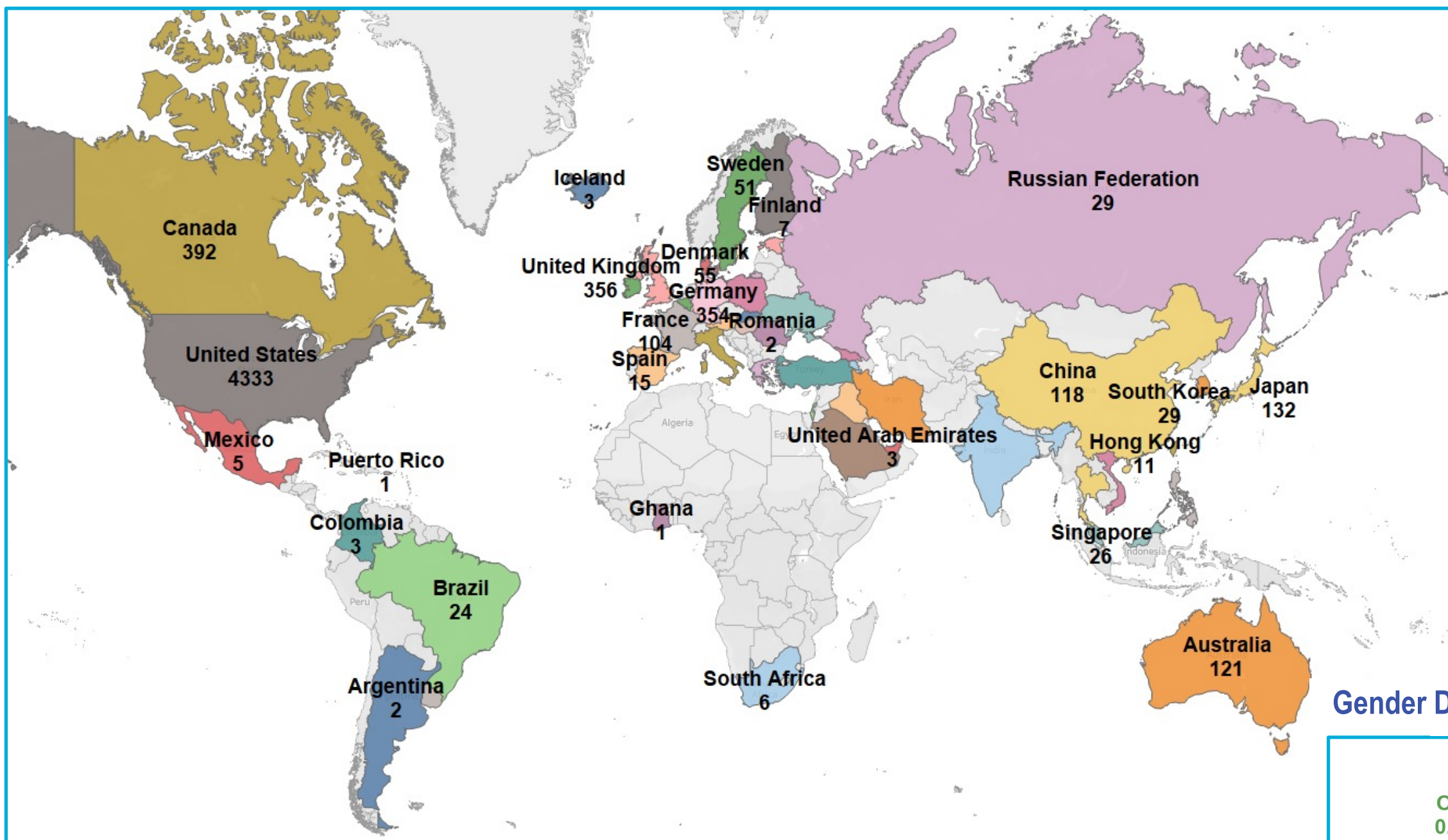
The Face of ASMS

Data derived from 2020 virtual conference registration*. 60% of attendees were ASMS members. Total Attendees: 6658

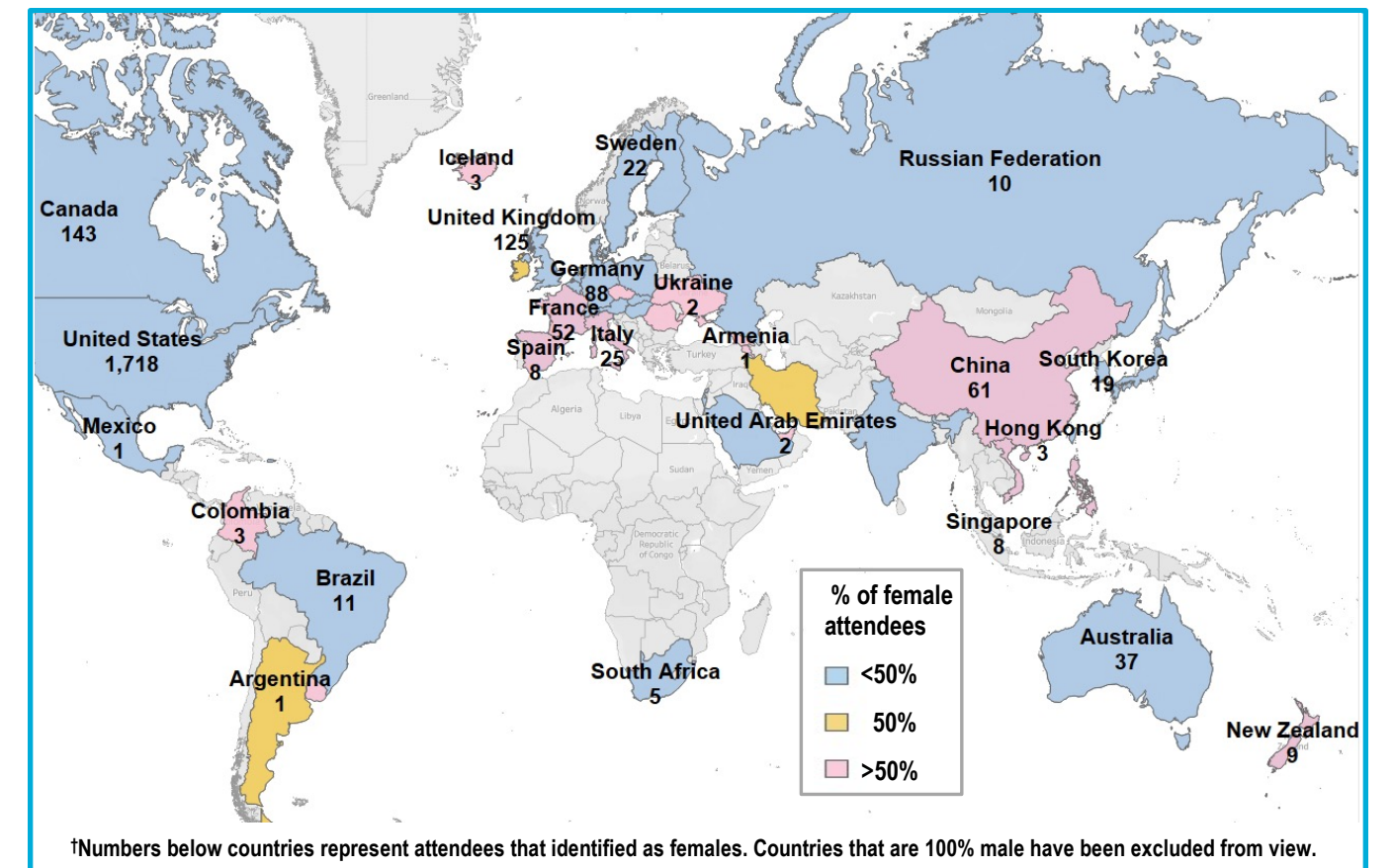
Where are the conference attendees of ASMS from?

The community is growing all over the world. More than 66% of the total attendees were based in the United States.



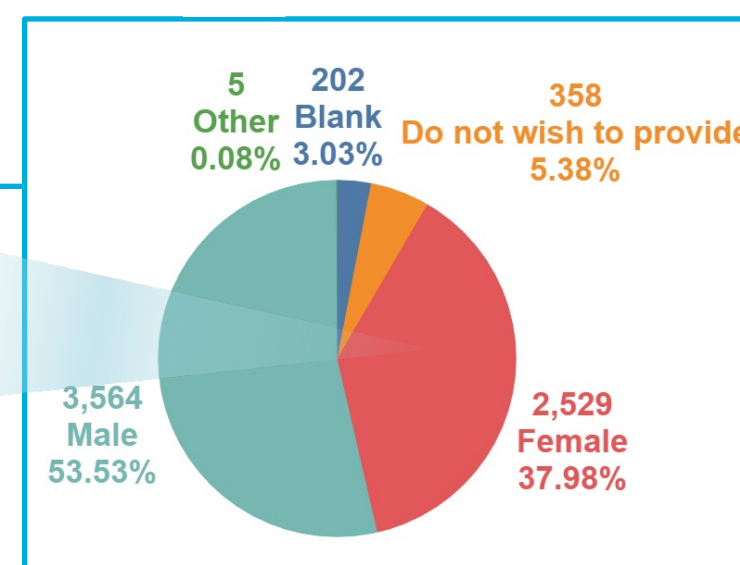
Female attendance by Country †

There were several countries with more female than male conference attendees such as Spain, China, France, Italy, New Zealand and others.

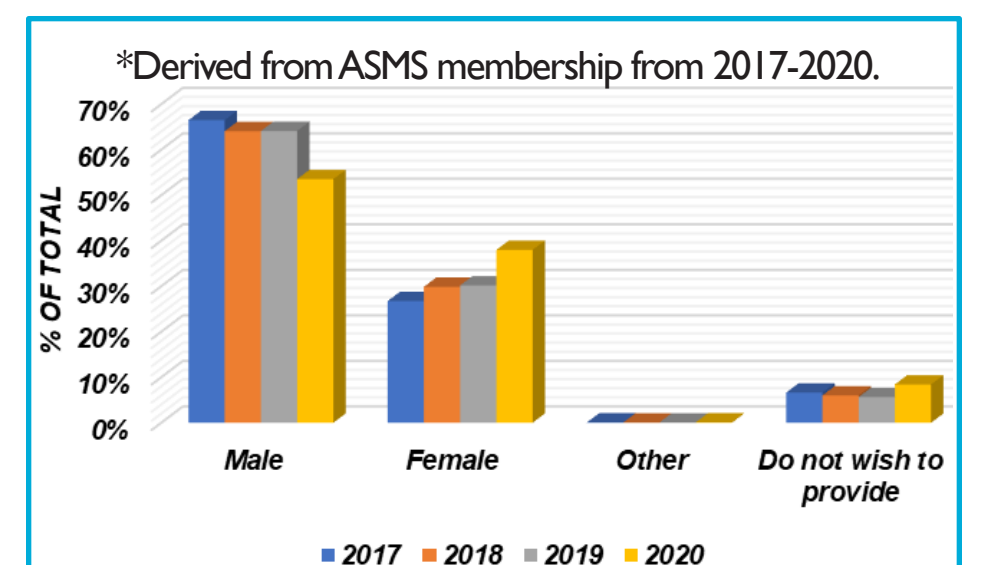


Gender Demographics

Gender Distribution-2020 Conference



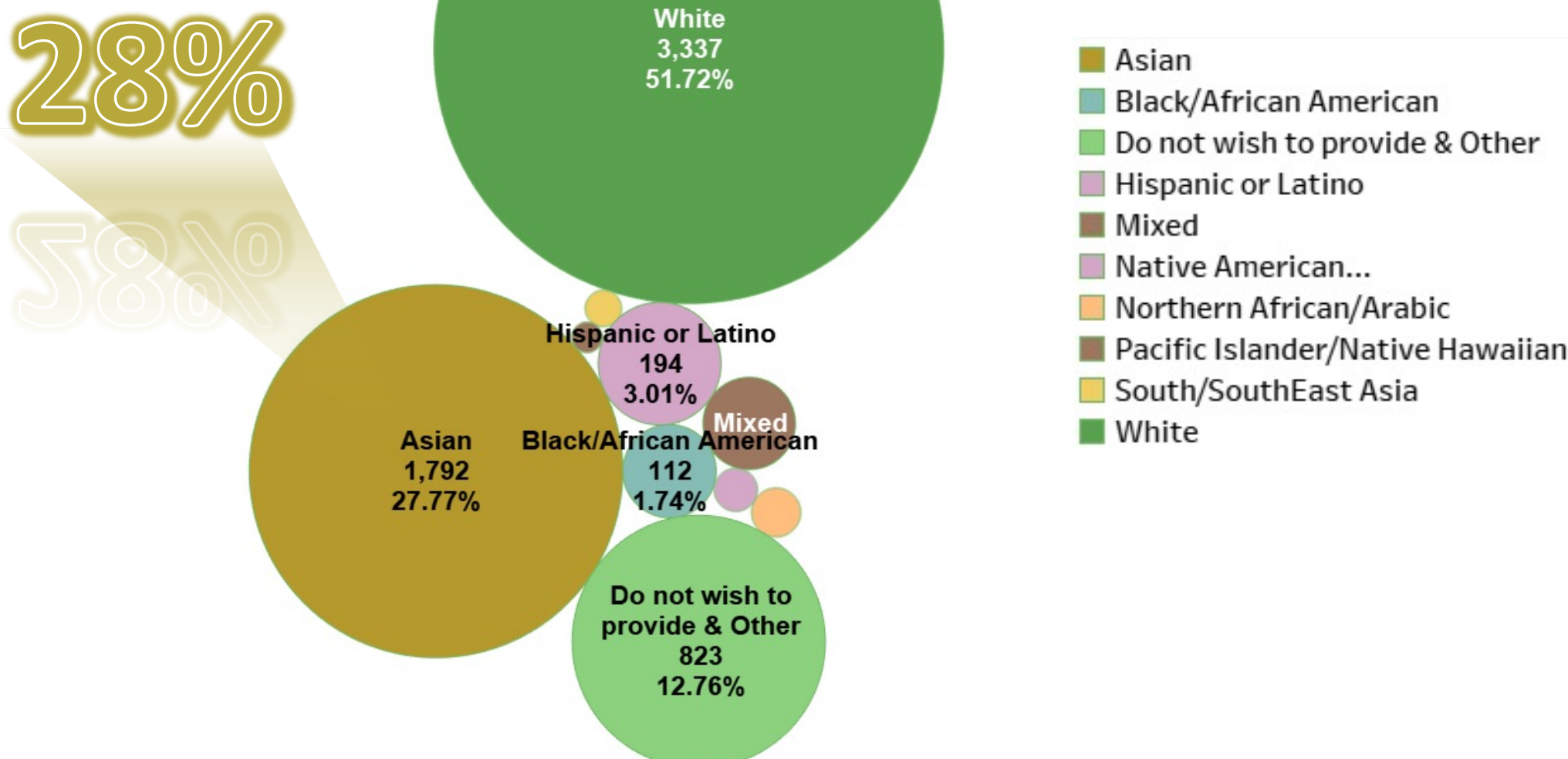
Gender % By Year (Membership)

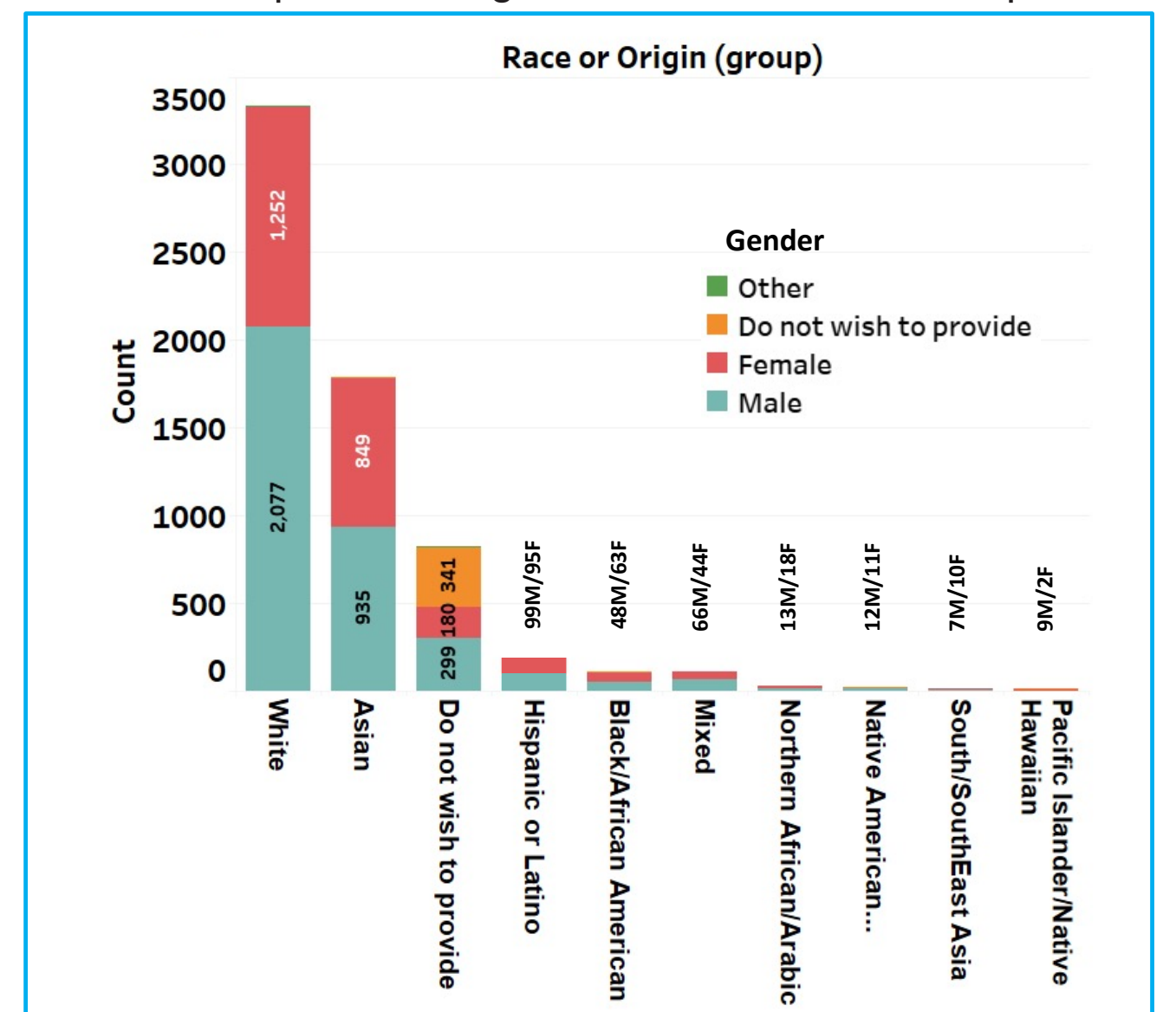
was the Female population attending ASMS in 2020. Female members have increased 4% year over year since 2017.

Numbers are provided for genders inside the bars where possible.

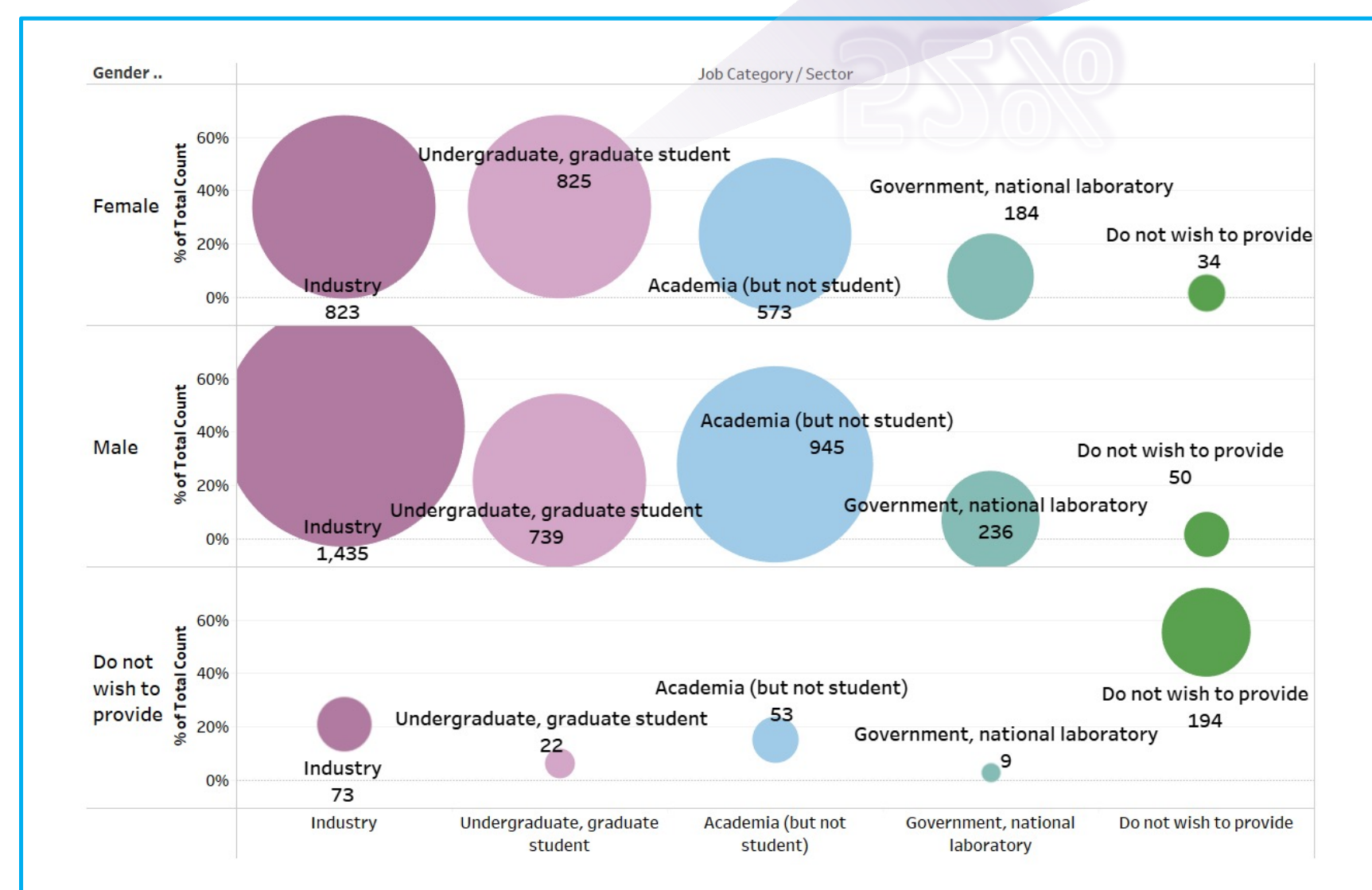


Job Categories by Gender
