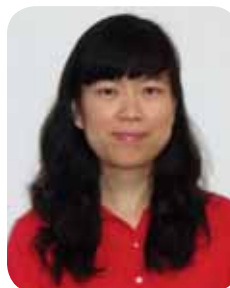

Meet the Editorial Board



Lingjun Li is Professor of Pharmaceutical Sciences and Chemistry at the University of Wisconsin-Madison (UW-Madison), USA. Dr. Li received her B.E. degree in Environmental Analytical Chemistry from Beijing University of Technology, China and her Ph.D. degree in Analytical Chemistry/Biomolecular Chemistry from the

University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign (UIUC) in 2000 under the supervision of Prof. Jonathan Sweedler. She then did a three-way postdoctoral research at the Pacific Northwest National Laboratory (Dr. Richard Smith), Brandeis University (Prof. Eve Marder), and UIUC (Jonathan Sweedler) before starting her independent career at UW-Madison in December 2002. Lingjun's research interests have been focused on the development of new chemical labeling strategies, microscale separations, *in vivo* microdialysis, comparative and quantitative proteomics and peptidomics strategies, and imaging mass spectrometry for functional discovery of neuropeptides in model organisms and protein biomarkers in neurodegenerative diseases. More recently, she and her research team are also exploring the novel use of ion mobility mass spectrometry in peptidomic research. Professor Li has published more than 160 peer-reviewed research journal papers and more than 10 book chapters. She has been recognized with numerous awards, including an NSF CAREER Award, a Sloan Research Fellowship, a 2004 ASMS Research Award, the 2011 Pittsburgh Conference Achievement Award, and most recently, the 2014 ASMS Biemann Medal. She then submitted to the ASMS Board for approval.

R. Graham Cooks, Henry Bohn Hass Distinguished Professor of Chemistry at Purdue University, has been named a 2014 National Academy of Inventors (NAI) Fellow. Election as an NAI Fellow is a high professional distinction accorded to academic inventors who have demonstrated a highly prolific spirit of innovation in creating or facilitating outstanding inventions that have made a tangible impact on quality of life, economic development, and the welfare of society.
