International Mass Spectrometry School

The 1st International Mass Spectrometry School was held Sept. 15-20th, 2013 in Siena, Italy. Organized by Professor Gianluca Giorgi (picture, front right), and attended by 90 students and 19 lecturers (11 international and 8 Italian) from 30 countries, this six day full immersion school provided fundamental and advanced lectures in mass spectrometry to graduate, Ph.D., post-doc students, and young scientists working in the areas of chemistry, biosciences, food, environment, and medicine.



Meet the Editorial Board



Frantisek Turecek (Editorial Board member 2013 - 2018) is Professor of Chemistry at University of Washington, Seattle. His research has resulted in over 370 publications, 2 books, and numerous book chapters concerning the chemistry of highly reactive molecules (enols, sulfenic acids), hypervalent radicals, nucleobase radicals related to

DNA damage, and peptide radicals and cation-radicals. His other interests include mass spectrometric instrumentation, gasphase ion chemistry, ion-surface interactions (soft and reactive landing), and applications to proteomics, clinical analysis, and newborn screening. Among his awards are the 2012 Thomson Medal of the International Mass Spectrometry Federation, the 2013 ACS Esselen Award for Chemistry in the Public Interest, and the 2010 Czech Head-Patria Science Prize. In addition to serving on several editorial boards he is one of the founding editors of *Journal of Mass Spectrometry*.
